



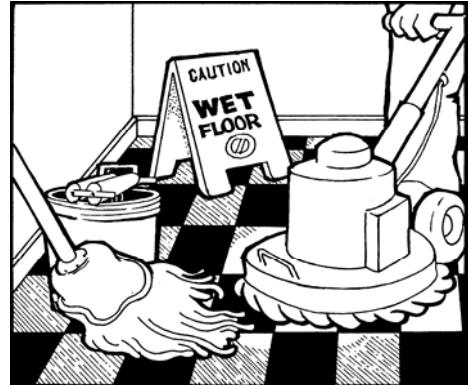

Hard Floor Care



Zip Strip is a fast, efficient, labour saving method for removing floor finishes and wax sealers with a minimum of scrubbing. **Zip Strip** is a low odour ammonia free stripping system. **Zip Strip** is caustic free and residue free.

MOP IT ON AND WATCH IT WORK ! **Zip Strip** quickly liquefies and suspends the sealer in a liquid emulsion which is easily removed with an autoscrubber or mop and bucket. Make sure to keep the surface wet at all time when stripping. **Zip Strip** can be used on vinyl, vinyl asbestos, rubber, no-wax linoleum, lino tile, marble, terrazzo, ceramic quarry tiles and most types of flooring.

DIRECTIONS: Depending upon the degree of sealer on the floor, **Zip Strip** can be diluted as follows:

	Zip Strip	Water
Heavy Build-up	1 part	4 parts
Moderate Build-up	1 part	6 parts
Light Build-up/	1 part	12 parts

Add recommended amount of **Zip Strip** to **cold water** and apply liberally to the floor. Allow to work for 3 to 5 minutes, being sure to keep the floor wet. In most situations it is advisable to wet scrub the floor using a black pad on an autoscrubber or a low speed machine with a black pad. Pick-up the dissolved sealer with an autoscrubber or mop and bucket. Rinse the floor with clean water and allow the floor to dry before applying the sealer. Note that since **Zip Strip** is residue free it is not absolutely necessary to rinse the floor after stripping.

FIRST AID: Keep Out of Reach of Children. **SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing. Wash with plenty of water. If severe irritation occurs, seek medical advice. **EYES:** Irrigate with copious amounts of water for 10 minutes. Seek medical advice. **INGESTION:** If poisoning occurs give 2 glasses of water, induce vomiting after 15 minutes. Seek Medical advice immediately or contact the Poisons Information Centre.
