Detergent	Product Application	Directions For Use	Safety Information
<b>CITRON</b> <i>Neutral Detergent</i>	<b>For Cleaning</b> Vinyl, terazzo, timber and ceramic tiled floors.	<b>Autoscrubber:</b> Dilute 12mL/L of water (1 Litre per 80 Litre Tank) <b>Mop &amp; Bucket:</b> Dilute 25mL/L of water (1/2 cup per 20 Litre bucket) <b>Spray &amp; Wipe:</b> Dilute 50mL/ L of water (25mL/ 500mL spray bottle)	<b>Skin Contact:</b> Wash skin thoroughly with water. <b>Ingestion:</b> DO NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water. Seek immediate medical advice. <b>Eyes:</b> Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if irritation persists.
<b>LEMON</b> <i>Disinfectant</i>	<b>For Cleaning</b> Bathrooms, washrooms, kitchen and amenities areas.	<b>Disinfection:</b> Dilute 20mL/Litre of water <b>Floor Cleaning:</b> Dilute 20mL/Litre of water <b>Spray &amp; Wipe:</b> Dilute 50mL/Litre of water <b>Deodourising:</b> Dilute 200mL/Litre of water	<b>Skin Contact:</b> Wash skin thoroughly with water. <b>Ingestion:</b> DO NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water. Seek immediate medical advice. <b>Eyes:</b> Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if irritation persists.
<b>ZEST</b> <i>Total Bathroom Detergent</i>	<b>For Cleaning</b> Toilets, urinals, wash basins, showers, ceramic tiles, floors and walls.	Invert the special applicator and apply under the rim of the bowl or urinal allowing the product to run into the bowl or urinal. Leave for a minimum of 10 minutes before flushing the toilet. For heavily stained or encrusted toilets leave for 10 minutes and scrub using a brush.	<b>Skin Contact:</b> Wash skin thoroughly with water. <b>Ingestion:</b> DO NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water. Seek immediate medical advice. <b>Eyes:</b> Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if irritation persists.
<b>CLEAR REFLECTIONS</b> <i>Window Cleaner</i>	<b>For Cleaning</b> Windows, mirrors, computer and TV screens, whiteboards, plastic and enamel.	Clear Reflections may be applied using a spray and a clean damp cloth or by using a squeegee and a bucket of window cleaner.	<b>Skin Contact:</b> Wash skin thoroughly with water. <b>Ingestion:</b> DO NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water. Seek immediate medical advice. <b>Eyes:</b> Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if irritation persists.
<b>FLORAL</b> <i>Air Freshener</i>	<b>For Deodorising</b> Toilets, washrooms, offices, kitchens and all common areas.	<b>Heavy Deodourisation:</b> Use undiluted <b>Moderate Deodourisation:</b> Dilute 200mL/Litre of water <b>Light Deodourisation:</b> Dilute 100mL/Litre of water	<b>Skin Contact:</b> Wash skin thoroughly with water. <b>Ingestion:</b> DO NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water. Seek immediate medical advice. <b>Eyes:</b> Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if irritation persists.
<b>SURFACE CLEAN</b> <i>Spray &amp; Wipe</i>	<b>For Cleaning</b> Inks, textas, benches, tables, counter tops, greasy soils, fats and oils.	<b>Spray and Wipe:</b> Permanent Ink & Heavy Soils: Use undiluted Normal Soils: 200mL/Litre of water Light soils: 100mL/Litre of water <b>Concrete Cleaning:</b> Heavy soils: 50mL/Litre of water Normal soils: 25mL/Litre of water	<b>Skin Contact:</b> Wash skin thoroughly with water. <b>Ingestion:</b> DO NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water. Seek immediate medical advice. <b>Eyes:</b> Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if irritation persists.
<b>RESOLVE</b> <i>Heavy Duty Detergent</i>	<b>For Cleaning</b> Kitchen areas, floors, walls, grease trays, range hoods, concealed equipment, pots and pans.	<b>Spray and Wipe:</b> Heavy Soils: Dilute 200mL/Litre of water Normal soils: Dilute 50mL/Litre of water <b>Floor Cleaning:</b> Dilute 20mL/Litre of water <b>Sanitising:</b> Dilute 20mL/Litre of water	<b>Skin Contact:</b> Wash skin thoroughly with water. <b>Ingestion:</b> DO NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water. Seek immediate medical advice. <b>Eyes:</b> Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if irritation persists.
